We do a lot of things for this Yom Tov...




- ••• Hear the Shofar on both days. (except when it is Shabbos, like this year)

- ... Eat a new fruit. (on second night)
- ... Throw our sins into water that has fish in.
























#### Rosh Hashana Crossword
