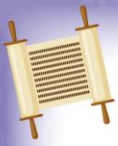

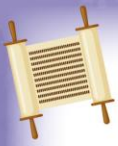

We do a lot of things for this Yom Tov...

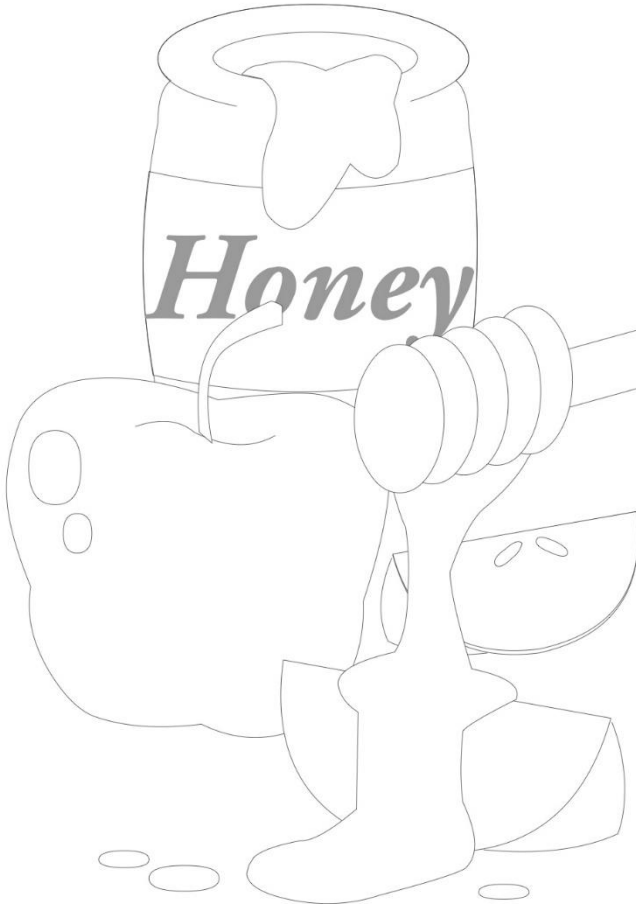
WE

- ... Hear the Shofar on both days. (except when it is Shabbos, like this year)
- ... Light candles on both nights.
- ... Eat Yom tov Meals.
- ... Dip the apple in the honey.
- ... Eat round challah.
- ... Have a fish or ram's head on the table.
- ... Eat pomegranates.
- ... Eat a new fruit. (on second night)
- ... Throw our sins into water that has fish in.





Apple dipped in honey

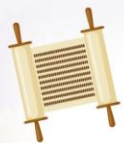

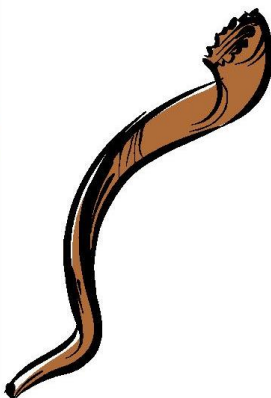


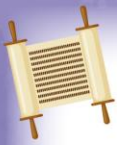


Rosh Hashana Match game

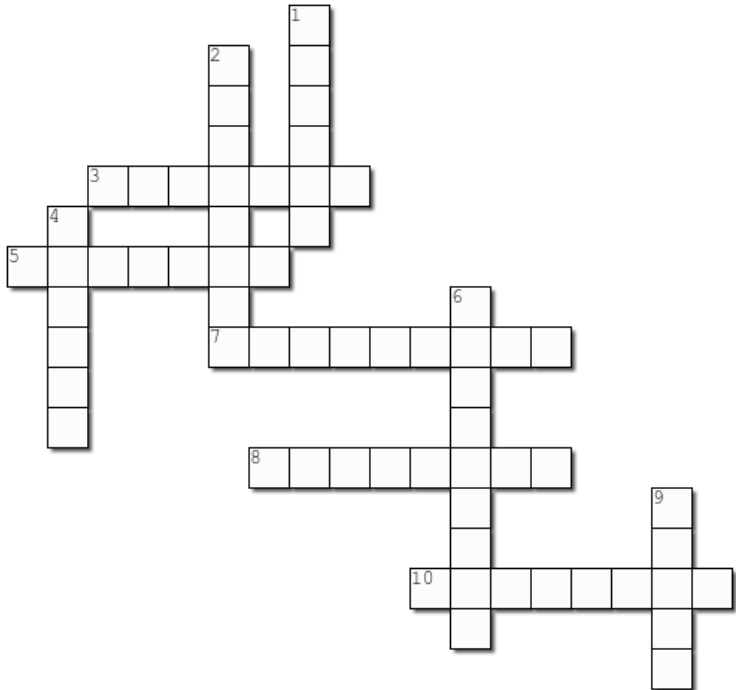






Rosh Hashana Crossword

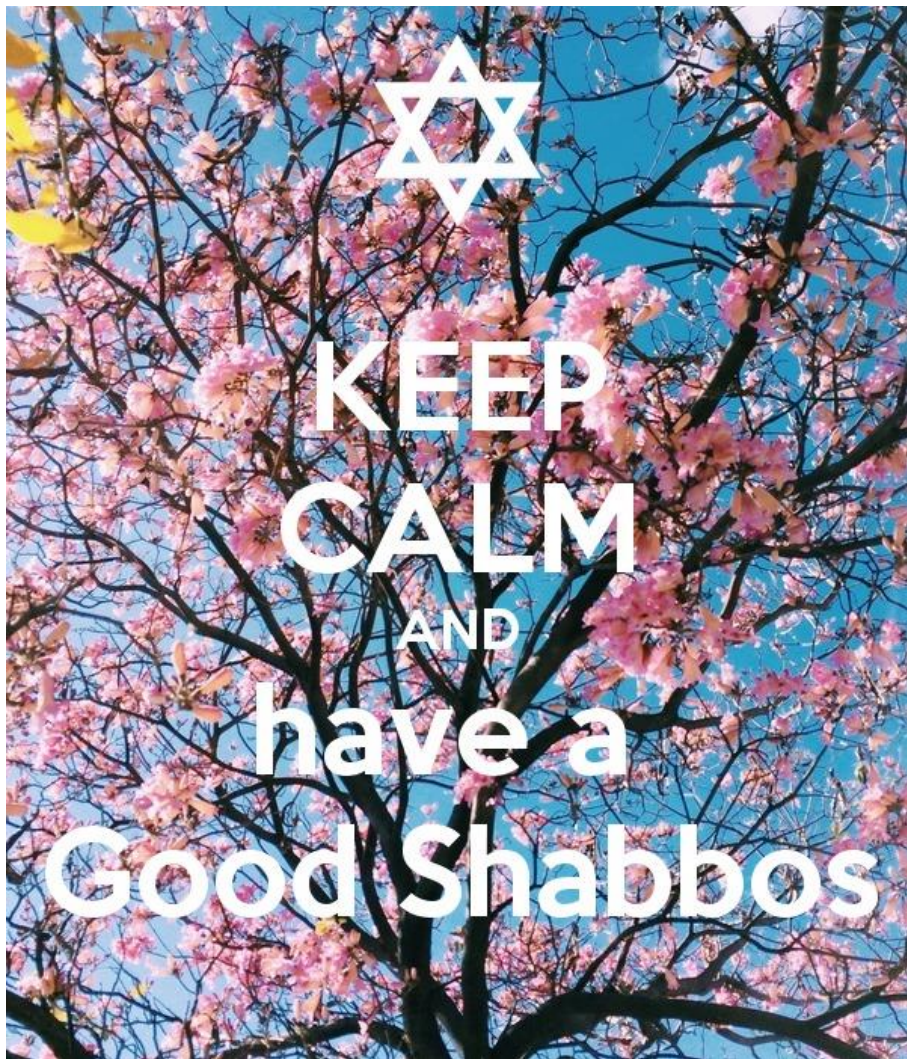
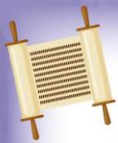
